Cutwork Instructions

Items you will need:

Fibrous water soluble stabilizer or tear away stabilizer Bobbin(s) to wind Spray adhesive if it is too small to hoop Scissors with a fine point (I like the blades with a curve)

We suggest that you wind your bobbin with the thread you will use when you embroider the cutwork designs if the back of embroidery will be visible (napkins, scarves, etc.).

Hoop the fabric with one piece of the stabilizer
After the cut line is stitched, trim the fabric to the inside of the cut
line. Do not cut the stabilizer.
Embroider the rest of the design.

If the item is too small to hoop:

Hoop one piece of the stabilizer.

Do a light spray of the adhesive on the stabilizer.

Adhere the item to the stabilizer.

After the cut line is stitched, trim the fabric to the inside of the cut line. Do not cut the stabilizer.

Embroider the rest of the design.

Note: If the item will be washed often we suggest that you use a fray inhibitor (We use Fray Block.)
