Aquarium Scenes Quilt Square Instructions

Items you will need:

- 2 Fat quarters in coordinating colors for each quilt square
- 10" X 10" Low loft batting for each quilt square
- Cut-away stabilizer
- Chalk wheel
- 2 small plastic curtain rings to hang quilt square

Use 1/2" seams to assemble the quilt squares.

- 1. Cut and/or mark fabric: Color 1, mark the 8" X 8" square with chalk wheel, cut after embroidery is complete. Color 2, cut two 8" X 2" for the sides, two 10" X 2" for the top and bottom, and cut one 10" X 10" for the back.
- 2. Mark center of the 8" X 8" square with chalk wheel.
- 3. Hoop the fabric with two pieces cut-away stabilizer
- 4. Embroider the designs. Cut the fabric and cut-away stabilizer to 8" X 8".
- 5. Stitch the 8" X 2" fabric to the sides of the embroidered piece. Stitch the 10 X 2" fabric to the top and bottom of the embroidered piece. Press seams.
- 6. Lay the back piece front side up, the embroidered piece front side down, then the batting. Pin.
- 7. Stitch the outside edge of the quilt square leaving an opening to turn right side out.
- 8. Turn. Stitch opening closed. Press.
- 9. Stitch in the ditch around the embroidered square.
- 10. Add small plastic curtain rings to hang the quilt square.
