Instructions for Gift Tags

For this project, you will need:

- Fibrous water soluble stabilizer
- Fabric scraps for the appliqués (front and back)
- Iron-on adhesive (i.e. Heat N Bond)
- Ribbon or string (to tie to package)

For each tag:

- 1. Wind bobbin(s) with coordinating thread.
- 2. Using iron-on adhesive, adhere 2 pieces of appliqué fabric, back-to-back (fabric should be approximately 1" larger than the size of the design being embroidered).
- 3. Hoop two pieces of fibrous water-soluble stabilizer.
- 4. Embroider the tag design. Place adhered appliqué fabric over the outline stitch, tape in place, and stitch the tack-down. Trim fabric close to the tack-down stitches. Proceed embroidering the remainder of the design. Design may have more than one appliqué.
- 5. Remove from hoop.
- 6. Trim water-soluble stabilizer close to the design. Dissolve remaining stabilizer in water or use wet cotton swab to dissolve away stabilizer.
- 7. Tie tag on gift with ribbon or string.

Note: If you want to cover the back of tags to hide lettering, etc., take another piece of fabric, the same size as the appliqué, and apply iron-on adhesive to the back of the fabric. Iron to the back of the tag. Trim away excess fabric.
