

In-the-Hoop Project requires larger than 5x7 Sewing Field



5x7 FORMATS: art, dst, exp, hus, jef, ofm, pes, vip, vp3, xxx 4x4 FORMATS: art, dst, exp, hus, jef, ofm, pcs, pes, sew vip, vp3, xxx Door Hanger Frame Formats: dst, ofm, exp.

## **Door Hanger Instructions**

*Items you will need:* Fibrous water soluble stabilizer

Fabric for the front & back of the Door Hanger

Fabric spray adhesive

Note: Wind bobbin with the top thread you will be using for the outline column.

**Note:** The outline and tackdown color changes are for the fabric area of the design. The outline is a running stitch that defines the Door Hanger shape. Your piece of fabric should be a little bigger than the outline. The tackdown is a running stitch line that will stitch the outline to tack down the fabric. Trim the fabric close to the tackdown stitches.

Note: Place the Hoop Outline "NFC" pattern into your software at the end of the color runs.

1. Hoop two pieces of fibrous water soluble stabilizer.



2. Using Spray Adhesive, spray the back of your fabric and lay it inside the hoop, be sure to have enough fabric to fill the hoop area. Once your fabric is in place sew out the design.



- 3. After the design has finished sewing, the outline will stitch. This will define the door hanger shape.
- 4. Adhere a matching piece of fabric to the back of the hoop with a light spray of adhesive and tape, using the outline as a reference.





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- 5. Stitch the second color change; which is the tack down stitch.
- 6. Remove the hoop from the machine.
- 7. Trim fabric on the outside of the tack down stitches. Do this to the front and back.



8. Embroider the rest of the design.



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- 9. Remove from the hoop.
- 10. Trim the stabilizer close to the fabric.
- 11. Use a small brush or Q-tip to apply water to dissolve the water soluble stabilizer.
- 12. Add ribbon or string to hang. Add any decor.
- 13. Your Door Hanger is now complete!
